FOR PARENTS AND CAMPERS:

We have set up a few private areas for campers and parents on the camptakodah.org website. For a few days at the start of each session (and at the end of the last session) we'll open up online registration for the website. Parents can register by entering name, email address, a username, and password. When your camper gets home you can help them register on the website and they'll be able to see the photos and participate in our "Camper Space" web forum.

WHY REGISTER?

PARENTS:

This username and password will let you access photos of this summer's camp sessions. You can also follow what's going on in the Camper's forum – and even chime in, if you want. (Please add a "signature" in the "Your Details" section of the forum, like "Joe's Mom" so the kids will know who they're talking to.)

CAMPERS:

In Camper Space you can post messages to your friends and share pictures from camp or from home.

There is a lot of concern about the risks of sharing personal information on the web, and even though this forum is only available to other campers, parents, staff and alumni of Camp Takodah, you should practice safe web participation. Don't post personal information including your address, phone number, or even your email address!

The Children's Online Privacy and Protection Act (COPPA) requires that children under the age of 13 get parental permission to participate on online activities that involve sharing of information.

If your parents didn't sign the form when they picked you up at camp, they can download it from the site, send it in, and we'll activate your account.
